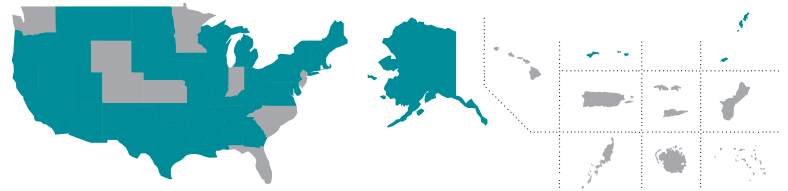


PRIORITY POLL 2018 RESEARCH
